

BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING
SOUTH JERSEY REGION – SPORTS CAR CLUB OF AMERICA, INC.
APRIL 2022

The April 2022 meeting of the Board of Directors for the South Jersey Region of the Sports Car Club of America, Inc. was held at the offices of Triple T Cutting Tools on Wednesday evening, April 6, 2022. The meeting was called to order by R.E., Jim Tornetta at 7PM.

Present were: Jim Tornetta, Steve Thomas, Joshua Kuhene, Sue King, Steve Kado and Bill Richter. Guests were: Bill VonSuskil, Jim Wakemen, Jr., and Matt Wojtkowiak.

Treasurer's Report - Sue King read Mike LaMaina's report. There is a balance of \$37,343.00 in the operating account, a balance of \$89,313.00 in the race account, a balance of \$4,229.00 in the scholarship account and \$20,000.00 on deposit with NJMP.

Membership Report - Sue King read John Hainsworth report. As of the beginning of April we have 518 members. 90 of those members have full competition licenses, 1 hillclimb license holder, 14 novice permits, and 43 TT licenses holders consisting of 24 novices, 16 intermediate, 2 advanced and 1 pro. We have a gain of 13 new members since the beginning of March 2022.

Rally Report – Jim Wakemen, Jr. reported that the Spring Tour Rally is scheduled for May 22, 2022 and will start at the Prestige Diner in Vineland, NJ. Entry fee is \$35.00.

Autocross Report – Jim Tornetta reported that the autocross schedule for April 24th at Bader Field may be subject to change. Bill Richter is in the process of firming up additional dates at Bader Field.

Old Business - Joshua Kuehne reported on tech day at Triple T. There were 15 autocross/time trials cars and 15 race cars. Joshua went on to report that he may have to change the May and October Time Trial dates scheduled to take place at Bader Field.

New Business - Sue King reported that she recently had a conversation with Dan Zane, co-chief of F&C wherein Dan stated that he spent \$250.00 in materials for the making of bags to hold the F&C phones. Jim Tornetta gave his approval to pay that bill.

Matt Wojtkowiak reported that he and several Men in Black will be making a day trip to Summit Point on April 23rd to assist WDCR tech. Matt has rented a van to transport everyone at the cost of \$436.00. Jim Tornetta gave his approval for \$250.00 to be paid by SJR toward this rental.

Bill VonSuskil reported that Performance Motorsports Network, which broadcasts the MARRS series events over their network, is looking for sponsorship. Those sponsors interested should contact Bill for further information. Bill went over the guests he will have for his April and May shows.

The April 2022 membership meeting will be held at Speed Raceway in Cinnaminson on Wednesday evening, April 13th. Jim Tornetta gave his approval for the club to pick up the tab for food.
