

BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING
SOUTH JERSEY REGION – SPORTS CAR CLUB OF AMERICA, INC.
SEPTEMBER 2022

The September 2022 meeting of the Board of Directors for the South Jersey Region of the Sports Car Club of America, Inc. was held at the home of J.D. King on Wednesday evening, September 7, 2022. The meeting was called to order by R.E., Jim Tornetta at 7:15PM.

Present were: J.D. King, Sue King, Bill Richter, Jim Tornetta, John Hainsworth, and Mike LaMaina. Guests were: Matt Wojtkowiak, Dan Zane, and Jim Wakemen, Jr.

Treasurers Report – Mike LaMaina reported that we have \$114,623.44 in our race account, \$35,286.91 in our operating account, \$3,628.61 in our scholarship account and \$20,000.00 on deposit with NJMP. Mike further reported that our Summer Thunder event had a loss of \$16,035.82 and that we are still waiting on deposits for two additional entrants for that event. Mike stated that overall feedback from that event was very positive. Sue King reported that she had received a letter from Christ Gospel Agape Community Life Center located in Whitesboro NJ. Sue explained that this is our annual charity for our autocross program. J.D. King made a motion that we send a donation of \$500.00 to Christ Gospel. Second by Bill Richter. Motion carried.

Membership Report – John Hainsworth reported that we have 515 members to date which includes 3 new members. 87 members hold completion licenses, 2 hold hillclimb permits, 11 hold novice permits, and 42 hold time trial permits.

Time Trials Report – Jim Tornetta gave Josh Kuehne's August TD/TT report wherein Josh stated that the August 6-7 Global Time Attack & SCCA National Tour events went well, weather was great and each group had about 40 drivers each. There were a few minor non-serious incidents. Both groups were very happy with the event and expressed interest in returning. The only negative complaint was from GTA as they were not happy with the EV team. Josh's report continued on our August 19-20 Summer Thunder event with 11 drivers for the Friday track day and 11 drivers for the Saturday Track spring with those drivers getting 7 competition runs and then fun runs. Next event will be the Fall Track Sprint at Bader Field on October 8th.

Autocross Report – Bill Richter reported on the August 16-17 Battle at the Bay event wherein there were a large group with a total of 102 entrants for the weekend each entrant getting 5 runs. There was a large group of teams that ran the Joker course with positive feedback from these teams. Next event is September 25th.

Rally Report = Jim Wakemen, Jr. reported on the Fall Road Rally scheduled for September 25th. This event starts at the Prestige Diner in Vineland. There are 10 entrants that have pre-registered. Jim Sr. is in the process of wrapping up the course for this event.

Race Report - J.D. King reported that we received a good observers report for our Summer Thunder event and he is looking forward to our October Jersey Road Racing event scheduled for October 21-23. We will be using the chicane. J.D. further reported that the track will be checked for any previous damage prior to our start Friday morning. Discussion centered on track flaggers. Dan Zane thanked all SJR members and the Board of Directors for their support while he was Chief of F&C. Dan stated that Jake Stahlman will now be Chief of F&C with Dennis Hand as Co-Chief.. J.D. King stated that we need to

give our 2023 race dates to NJMP by October 1st. The NeDiv race schedule has yet to be finalized. Discussion centered on what dates we should use and how many race events we should plan for 2023, with possible three races, two regionals and one Majors.. Dates suggested: Majors, July 14=16 on Thunderbolt; Lightning Challenge, June 23=25 on Lightning; and The Jerk, October 20=22 on Lightning.

New Business – Jim Toretta reminded all that we have upcoming events which are the 2022 elections and our 2023 banquet.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 8:25PM.
